

- 4-1-5 CONNECTION REQUIREMENTS
The City of St. Elmo shall charge \$25.00 for each permit authorizing connection to the municipal sewer system.
- 4-1-6 TIME PAYMENTS BEGIN
All persons who procure permits to make a tap on the sewer line shall begin to pay their use fee as of the date that the tap is made.
- 4-1-7 CONNECTIONS TO PUBLIC SEWER
Before any connection is made to a public sewer, an approved permit for such connection must be obtained from the Superintendent. Each connection shall be made at the "Y" designated for that property. The only exception shall be where the designated "Y" is not located within three feet of the point of measurement furnished. Any connection not made at the designated "Y" in the main sewer shall be made under the direct supervision of the Superintendent. A "Y" or "T" fitting shall be installed near the building foundation to provide for clean out purposes. All hook-ups, tap-ins and the materials used therein must be in conformity with specifications made by the Water and Sewer Superintendent. Such specifications will be made available to the public at the City Hall. Any variances to this section must be requested in writing to said Superintendent.
- 4-1-8 RAIN WATER LEADERS
Roof, leaders, surface drains and ground water drains shall not be connected to the sanitary sewer.
- 4-1-9 SEWER INSPECTOR
All permits provided for herein shall be issued by the Superintendent. The Superintendent shall have the duty to inspect all taps on to the public sewer line and to see that all provisions of this ordinance are properly administered and enforced. He shall cause to be kept a record of measurement of all sewer taps in relation to property lines.
- 4-1-10 SEWER TAP INSPECTION
The Superintendent shall be notified by the person making the tap-on to the public sewer line when the work is begun and when it is ready for inspection. All such work shall be left uncovered and convenient for examination until inspected and approved. The Superintendent shall examine the work within one day after receipt of notice that the work is ready for inspection. All defective materials and work must be replaced and corrected. Upon satisfactory completion of the work, the Superintendent shall issue a letter of certificate of approval.
